


The little car with the big fun factor was on display at Auckland's Western Springs over Labour Weekend as Mini lovers from around the country met for the sixth annual New Zealand National Mini Meet.

"When you hop in a Mini it puts a smile on your face," said 68-year-old Bill Pyne, of Waikanae, who drove his 1968 Mini Countryman Mark II automatic from Waikanae for the event.

The sparkling green car has a top speed of about 130 km/h and has been lovingly restored over the past two years. Every piece of the car, including the exterior wood, was imported from Britain. Not a bad end for a car that was "a toss-up whether it went to the tip," Mr Pyne said. it is insured for \$20,000 but is not, for sale. About 70 Mini owners gathered for the event, with Minis ranging. from modified racers with 1600cc Honda engines to the more sedate Mini version of the station wagon.

All of them had the same reason for loving the Mini — it's a fun car.

"I don't even drive it, I just like. looking at it," said Wayne Kara, 26, talking about his 1964 Mini Cooper, which he painted and restored seven years ago. "It doesn't really drive that nice"

The Mini was a trailblazer when it first rolled off the production line in 1959. It was the, smallest car made at the time and was very economical to run.

Auckland Mini Car Club President Warwick Robinson said that, with increased fuel prices, Minis could become more popular than ever.
